THE HOST CITY

LA LÍNEA DE LA CONCEPCIÓN

Located at the southernmost point of continental Europe, La Línea de la Concepción stands at one of the most unique maritime crossroads in Europe, where the Mediterranean Sea meets the Atlantic Ocean alongside the iconic Strait of Gibraltar.

Deeply connected to the sea, history and cultural exchange, the city has been shaped by its strategic position beside Gibraltar and the Strait for centuries. Originally established as a military settlement during the 18th century, La Línea grew around the defensive fortifications built to oversee Gibraltar, later evolving into a vibrant coastal community strongly linked to maritime culture, trade and cross-border relations.

Today, La Línea represents far more than a border city. Combining Mediterranean lifestyle, Andalusian culture and a strong nautical identity, it has become an important destination for water sports and outdoor activities. Its extensive beaches, open coastal landscapes and spectacular views of the Rock of Gibraltar create a truly distinctive setting for international sporting events.

Poniente Beach, the official venue of the Championships, offers wide sandy areas, direct access to the city centre and ideal sea conditions for Beach Sprint and Coastal Rowing competitions. Its natural layout and surrounding infrastructure provide both athletes and spectators with an exceptional event experience.

La Línea enjoys a mild Mediterranean climate with Atlantic influences, characterised by pleasant temperatures throughout the year and consistent wind conditions that make the area particularly attractive for water sports. Combined with the city's hospitality, accessibility and maritime atmosphere, these natural conditions position La Línea de la Concepción as an outstanding host city for international rowing events. Beyond sport, visitors will discover a unique blend of gastronomy, culture and Mediterranean spirit. From beachfront restaurants and lively tapas bars to local markets and traditional seafood cuisine, the city reflects the authentic character and vibrant atmosphere of southern Spain.

La Línea also preserves important cultural and historical elements linked to the Campo de Gibraltar region and Andalusian heritage. Visitors can explore the historic town centre, enjoy cultural venues such as the Cruz Herrera Museum, or simply experience the singular atmosphere created by the interaction of Spanish, British and Mediterranean influences. Nature and sea lovers will equally find an exceptional destination, with panoramic coastal views, spectacular sunsets over the Bay of Gibraltar and easy access to nautical activities throughout the year.

Blending sport, culture, history and maritime tradition, La Línea de la Concepción provides an unforgettable setting for athletes, spectators and international rowing communities alike.

WEATHER

LA LÍNEA DE LA CONCEPCIÓN

La Línea de la Concepción has a mild Mediterranean climate with strong Atlantic influences, characterised by moderate temperatures throughout the year, abundant sunshine and occasional windy conditions due to its coastal location near the Strait of Gibraltar. Rainfall is mainly concentrated during the autumn and winter months, while summers are generally warm and dry.

The average annual temperature is approximately 18°C, with pleasant weather conditions prevailing for most of the year. July and August are the warmest

months, with average maximum temperatures of around 28°C and minimum temperatures between 21°C and 22°C. January is typically the coldest month, with average maximum temperatures of approximately 15°C and minimum temperatures close to 10°C.

Average annual precipitation is approximately 690 mm, with the wettest period occurring between November and January. During the summer months, rainfall is minimal, providing stable and favourable conditions for outdoor sporting events.

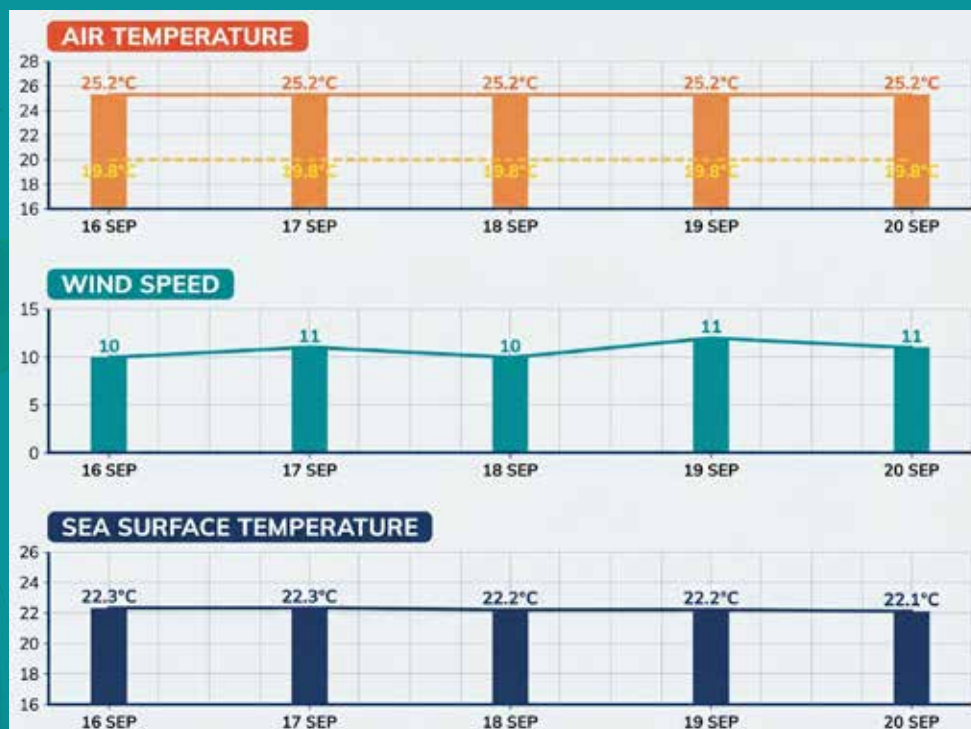

VENUE AND COURSE DETAILS

EUROPEAN ROWING BEACH SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Course Layout Start and Finish: On the beach, marked with start/finish, arch, and lane flags.
- Distance: 250m out, 250m back.
- Format: During the Time Trial phase, athletes will start individually at one-minute intervals and will be required to complete the course illustrated in Image 1. Following the Time Trials, the qualified athletes will progress to the head-to-head elimination rounds, where competitors will race in pairs (1vs1) following the course illustrated in Image 2.

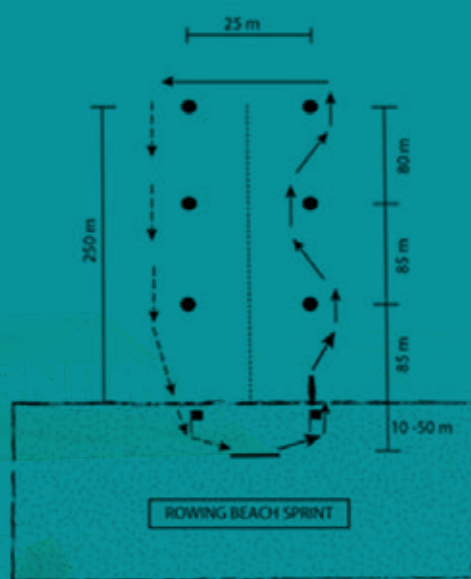

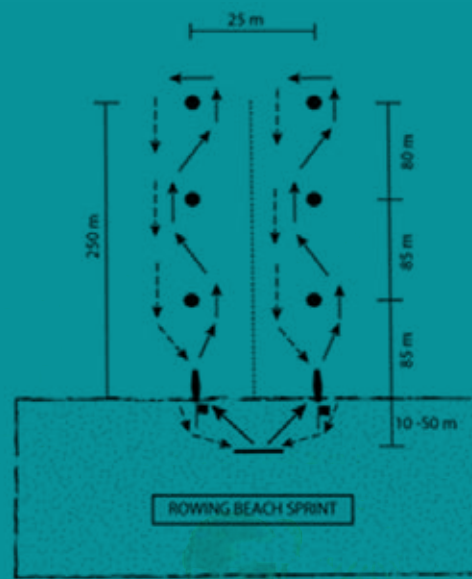

EUROPEAN ROWING COASTAL & CLUB COASTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Course Layout Start and Finish: Starting in the water and finishing on the beach.
- Distance: Masters events will race over 3,000m. Open category Heats and B Finals will be raced over 4,000m. A Finals will be raced over 6,000m.
- Format: Veteran categories will complete one lap of Course 1 (3000m), while all other categories will complete one lap of Course 2 (4000m). Crews qualified for the B Finals will repeat the same course, whereas the A Finals will be raced over a 6000m course, consisting of two laps of Course 1.

UNIFORM & BLADES

Each crew member shall display on their racing shirt or equivalent their three-letter Member Federation code and their family name (in Romanised text), centred on the torso of the rower. The family name must appear above the federation code in the following manner and format:

SHARED USE POOL OARS – BLADE GUIDELINES:

The blades of pool oars used by multiple crews may be of plain (solid) colour.

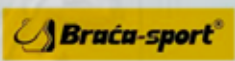
The colours and design of the blades of all oars and sculls shall be identical on both sides.

There is no requirement to apply national identification stickers to the blades.

It is the responsibility of all participating clubs and Member Federations to comply with the **World Rowing Rules of Racing**.
